THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

The Cub Resident Camp is for all Cub Scouts and family members. Registration deadline is July 11, 2010.

All participants (to include adults) are required to have a completed Annual Health and Medical form. Forms A & C should be completed. The form can be found on the council website "Publication" page under Scouting Safely. Forms A & C do not require a doctors examination or signature. Filling out ahead of time will save time on check in. www.eccbsa.org

Fee Refund Policy

All refund requests must be in writing and mailed to the East Carolina Council Office. Refunds are not given at camp. Request received prior to July 11th – all fees will be returned minus. Request received after July 11th – all fees minus \$20 per Scout. **Refund request for "no shows" will not be honored.** Refund request for Scouts or Parents who depart camp early will not be honored.

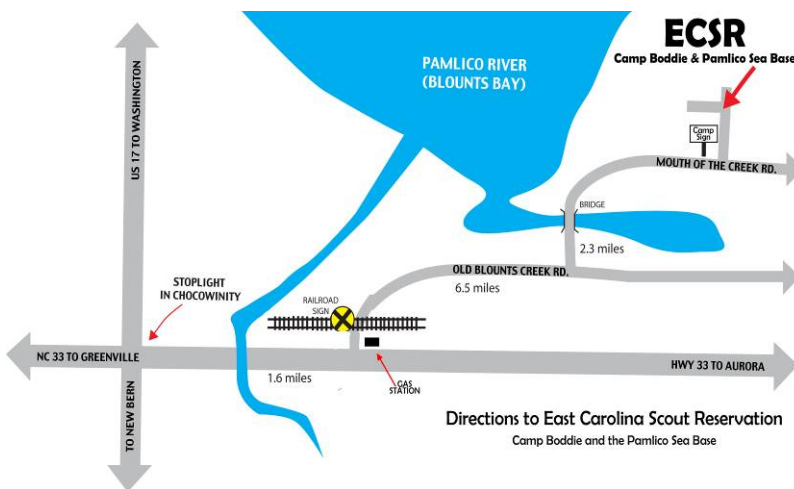
