

The Application Form for 2013 National Scout Jamboree Troop and Venturing Patrol Adult Leadership Positions is Now Available.

General Information

1. East Carolina Council will form a contingent of three Jamboree Scout Troops and one Jamboree Venturing Patrol beginning in the fall of 2011. These units will attend the 2013 National Scout Jamboree at the BSA's *Summit Bechtel Reserve* in West Virginia. The Jamboree opens on July 15, 2013 and closes on July 24, 2013. Scouts from the northern, central, and southern areas of the Council will comprise the Jamboree troops. Venturing crew members from throughout the Council will form the Jamboree Venturing Patrol.
2. Each troop will have four adult leaders and thirty-six Scouts. The Venturing Patrol will have two adult leaders and eight Venturing members.

Qualifications

- Jamboree troop leaders must have a current BSA membership in a Boy Scout Troop. Jamboree Venturing leaders must have a current BSA membership in a Venturing Crew. All Jamboree troop and Venturing leaders must complete Youth Protection Training within one year of July 15, 2013, and all must serve as role models of physical fitness.
- Jamboree Scoutmasters must be at least 21 years of age on July 15, 2013, must be leader specific trained, and must currently serve as Scoutmasters.
- Jamboree First Assistant Scoutmasters must be at least 21 years of age on July 15, 2013, and must currently serve in a leadership position within a troop.
- Jamboree Second Assistant Scoutmasters must at least 18 years of age on July 15, 2013, and must currently serve in a leadership position within a troop.
- Jamboree Third Assistant Scoutmasters must be at least 18 years of age on July 15, 2013, and not yet 21 on July 24, 2013.
- Jamboree Venturing Advisors must be at least 21 years of age on July 15, 2013, must be leader specific trained, and must currently serve as a crew Advisor or Associate Advisor.

Application Process

STEP ONE. Open the 2013 National Scout Jamboree web page at this link: <https://summit.scouting.org/en/Jamboree2013/Pages/default.aspx>. Click on the "Adult Leader" tab and read all the information under "Boy Scout" or "Venturing" as appropriate. **It is important to carefully review the application instructions before actually beginning this process.** Then complete the application at the "Application Instruction" tab. Once the application is submitted, proceed to step two.

STEP TWO. Complete and return to East Carolina Council the “Application for Troop/Venturing Adult Leadership Position.” Applications are due on or before October 15, 2011. The application form is available on-line at the East Carolina web site or at the Council office. Shortly after October 15, 2011, you will be notified regarding the time and location for a personal interview, which is step three.

STEP THREE. When scheduled, appear before an East Carolina Council personnel committee for an interview. This committee will make recommended Jamboree leadership assignments and forward these recommendations to the Scout Executive for council approval.
