

QUALIFICATIONS FOR SCOUT PARTICIPANTS, UNIT SCOUTMASTERS, VENTURING PARTICIPANTS, VENTURING ADVISORS, AND STAFF FOR 2013 NATIONAL JAMBOREE

SCOUT PARTICIPANT QUALIFICATIONS

- * Must have a current BSA membership with a Boy Scout troop or Varsity Scout team.
- * Must be at least First Class Scout.
- * Must be at least 12 years of age by the first day of the jamboree or an 11 year old that has graduated the 6th grade, but has not reached their 18th birthday by the last day of the jamboree.
- * Must be approved by his unit leader and the East Carolina Council Jambo Committee..
- * Must participate in pre-jamboree training experience.
- * Must have filed a Jamboree Personal Health and Medical record with the East Carolina Council Jamboree Committee no later than 1 March 2013.
- * Must submit all registration fees per the East Carolina Council's payment schedule.

SCOUTMASTER QUALIFICATIONS

ALL JAMBOREE SCOUTMASTERS, FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD ASSISTANT SCOUTMASTERS MUST MEET THE FOLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- * Must have a current BSA membership with a Boy Scout Troop or Varsity Scout Team.
- * Scoutmasters and First Assistant Scoutmasters must be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.
- * Second Assistant Scoutmaster must be at least 18 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.
- * Third Assistant Scoutmaster must be at least 18 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree but not yet 21 years of age by the last day of the Jamboree.
- * Scoutmaster and First Assistant Scoutmaster must be serving as a Scoutmaster or Varsity Coach.
- * For Second and Third Assistant Scoutmasters, be currently serving in any adult troop or team leadership position.
- * Completed Scoutmaster or Varsity Scout Coach leader specific training.
- * Completed youth Protection Training within one year of the first day of the jamboree.
- * Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- * Must participate in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- * Must have filed a Jamboree Personal Health and Medical record with the East Carolina Council Jamboree Committee no later than 1 March 2013.
- * Be approved by the East Carolina Council Jamboree Committee and Council Executive.
- * Must submit all registration fees per the East Carolina Council's payment schedule.

VENTURING PARTICIPANT QUALIFICATIONS

- * Crew members must have a current BSA membership with a Venturing crew.
- * Must have graduated the 8th grade or be at least 14 years of age by the first day of the jamboree, but have not reached their 21st birthday by the last day of the jamboree.
- * Must participate in pre-jamboree training experience,.

- * Must be approved by his unit leader and the East Carolina Council Jambo Committee
- * Must have filed a Jamboree Personal Health and Medical record with the East Carolina Council Jamboree Committee no later than 1 March 2013.
- * Must submit all registration fees per the East Carolina Council's payment schedule.

VENTURING ADVISOR QUALIFICATIONS

VENTURING ADVISORS MUST MEET THE FOLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- * Must have a current BSA membership with a Venturing Crew.
- * Be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.
- * Completed Venturing Leader Specific training.
- * Completed Youth Protection training within one year if the first day of the jamboree.
- * Be actively serving as a crew Advisor or Associate Advisor.
- * Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- * Must have participated in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- * Must have filed a Personal Health and Medical Record with the East Carolina Council Jamboree Committee no later than 1 March 2013.
- * Be approved by the East Carolina Council Jamboree Committee and Council Executive.
- * Must submit all registration fees per the East Carolina Council's payment schedule.

JAMBOREE STAFF QUALIFICATIONS

- * Must have a current BSA membership.
- * Completed Youth Protection Training within one year of the first day of the jamboree.
- * Ability to arrive on site at the jamboree up to but not limited to one week before the jamboree as deemed necessary by the service director of the area selected to serve in to receive training and assist in the final preparations for troop arrivals.
- * Be at least 16 years of age by the first day of the jamboree.
- * Submit all registration fees per the published payment schedule.
- * Complete any jamboree specific training as deemed necessary by the service director of the area selected to serve in.
- * File a Personal Health and Medical Record as instructed by the deadline.
- * Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- * Be approved by the East Carolina Council Executive.
