

Camper Outdoor Skills Training Weekend

- What is it:** This weekend will provide Scouts the opportunity to work on their outdoor skills requirements for Tenderfoot, 2nd & 1st Class rank advancement.
- Participants will set up a model campsite in the Outdoor Skills area and perform as a patrol during the weekend (four patrols of 8).
- When:** Check in begins at 6:00-7:00 p.m. on Friday and the event concludes Sunday at 12:00 noon. First meal is Saturday breakfast.
- Where:** Herbert C. Bonner Scout Reservation, Blount's Bay near Chocowinity, NC.
- Cost:** The weekend youth cost is \$35.00 and includes meals/materials. The event must have 16 (minimum) Scouts registered by October 31st for the event to take place. All adults are \$20.00.
- Housing:** Participants need to plan on sleeping in their own tents & bring their personal camping equipment for the weekend. Adults may camp in a separate area.
