



Become a Tartan Guard Unit of the East Carolina Council

The Tartan Guard Unit Award recognizes those Packs, Troops and Crews in the East Carolina Council who deliver a great Scouting program to their Scouts.

Units that meet the requirements to become a Tartan Guard Unit will receive:

- ✓ ***A Tartan Guard Flag Streamer***
- ✓ ***Free cloth rank advancements in the Scout Shop in Kinston for 12 months***
- ✓ ***The Council camp weekend campsite fee will be waived. Effective January 1, 2006 a fee of \$2 per person is charged for weekend camping. This fee will be waived for Tartan Guard units for District Camporees, Council Camporees and unit camping that takes place at a Council property.***
- ✓ ***Your Unit and Chartered Organization will be listed on the Council website***

Requirements for all units:

- ✓ ***Qualify as a Centennial Quality Unit***
- ✓ ***Participate in one or more unit Good Turn for America Projects or Council Good Turn and log it onto the Good Turn for America website***
- ✓ ***Schedule, conduct and support a unit FOS presentation from January through April 2008. Achieve a goal of (Youth Registration on 12/31/07 x .15) x \$96.00 or exceed 2007 total raised***
- ✓ ***Attend the 2008 Council Program Extravaganza***
- ✓ ***Participate in the 2008 Council Trails End Popcorn Sale and achieve a goal of \$30 in sales for every youth registered on 12/31/07***
- ✓ ***Attend Camp (Packs must attend Cub Scout Day Camp or Council Summer Cub Adventures, Troops must attend the Council Annual Camporee and have attended Bonner Scout Reservation a total of six nights in 2008. Crews must attend at least one Council Venturing program during the year).***
- ✓ ***Participate in the annual membership recruiting plan for your unit (Packs must schedule and hold a Round Up Night, Troops must hold a Troop Open House and invite graduating Webelos)***
- ✓ ***A leader must have participated in the planning or operation of a District or Council event.***

Those units who receive the Tartan Guard unit award in 2008 will receive free rank advancements from January 1 to December 31, 2009. Your completed and signed application must be received at the Perry Family Service Center no later than December 31, 2008 to be recognized and to receive free rank advancement in 2009.
