Registration: To sign up for this program complete the ECC Properties Use Permit/Procedures and submit to the Council Office. Please note any specific project you would like to work on under "Special Request" along with any resources you can provide to complete the project.

Cost: There is no cost for the program and the campsite fee will be waived for the weekend. Units are also welcome to come to Camp and work on their project just for the day.

Project Details: Service projects must be a minimum of 4 hours. Projects include conservation work, trail repair, landscaping, and painting. Refer to the Camp Maintenance Work list for a full listing of projects at the Reservation.
