

East Carolina Council 2010 National Jamboree Contingent

Council Contingent Organization: East Carolina Council will field three (3) provisional troops for the Jamboree. Each troop will consist of 36 Scouts and four (4) leaders for a contingent total of 120 participants.

Youth Qualifications: A Scout must certify that he has, or will have by July 1, 2010 attained the following qualifications: must be a First Class Scout, must have completed the 6th grade or be at least 12 years of age by July 1, 2010, but not have reached his 18th birthday by August 3, 2010, must participate in all pre-Jamboree training and meetings, be active in a troop for at least six months prior to July 1, 2010, be approved by his unit leader and the East Carolina Council Jamboree Committee.

East Carolina Council's Jamboree Fee: Includes the Jamboree fees established by the National Council, travel from gateway city to National Jamboree and return from National Jamboree site to gateway city, all meals, lodging, unit and patrol equipment, accident and sickness insurance, pre-jamboree training weekend, council, regional and national office administrative program support. **The cost does not include** travel to or from any pre-jamboree training, unit meeting's, travel to and from gateway city, or ticketing due to early or late departure from the Jamboree site due to medical emergencies, family emergencies and/or problem's based on our Jamboree code of conduct. **Additional expenses** will include personal equipment, uniforms and spending money for souvenirs, snacks, etc. Although the final ECC Jamboree fee is yet to be established, it is anticipated to be \$1,300+.

Registration Process: All youth applicants must complete an on-line application through the National Jamboree website. Applicants will be directed to print their confirmation, have it signed by their unit leader and submit to the council service center along with a \$100.00 non-refundable deposit. Further payments will be made to the council service center utilizing a fees payment transmittal form.

Registration is on a first-come-first served basis. Once all 108 youth participant slots are filled, an alternates list will be established.
