



New Youth & Adult Application Information



As of August 1, the BSA has a new single application for youth that replaces the Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Venturer, Varsity and Exploring applications.

These applications are larger and easier to read than past applications. There are two copies of this application; one for the Local Council and one for the unit.

A significant benefit to this application is that it can be scanned instead of having to key punch all of the information.

The East Carolina Council has purchased a scanner to significantly speed up the processing of new applications during both Fall Round Up and during recharter.

The new youth applications are available for Cub Scout Packs who attending Fall Round Up Trainings and will also be available at Roundtables this fall. We ask that you limit the number of applications that you take to a realistic amount.

The new applications will also be included in Recharter packets for Packs, Troops and Crews.

It is important to note “old” applications can still be utilized but do not have the ability to be scanned.

There is also a new Adult application that can be scanned and it is also in a version that is able to be scanned.
