



Put the Outing in Scouting

East Carolina Council is privileged to have six camping areas for use by our Scouting units. Each area is unique in what it can bring to your unit outdoor program.

Camp Bonner, South

Bonner, South is our primary resident camping program area. It offers all the standard camp facilities associated with a long term camping experience. 10 campsites with shelters, shower facilities, dining hall, sleeping quarters, reception center, swimming pool, water front, COPE course, shooting range, sports field are but a few of the many facilities available at Bonner, South. The camp is available to all scout and non-scout organization use.

Pamlico Sea Base

The Sea Base was developed as the focal point for the council's high adventure Venturing & Sea Scout programs. The Pamlico Sea Base is equipped to handle sailing and sea kayaking trek request. Facilities include a large conference center for training opportunities, coed shower facilities, campsite area, bunkhouse, and two family cabins that sleep 10 each. The facility is available for scout unit and non-scout organization use.

Camp Bonner, North

Bonner, North is our primitive camping area. It has wide open areas suitable for large unit or district events. It's a great place to conduct troop outdoor skills training or large pack activities. Water is available on-site but we suggest that you rent port-a-johns for event use.

Camp Hannah Bonner

A small but well developed camp facility, Hannah Bonner is the perfect place to conduct a Pack Cub Family Campout. There's a small dining hall and limited shower and bathroom facilities, a shooting range for BB gun and archery, sports area, program shelter and numerous campsite areas.

Camp Charles

A beautiful camp location on a large lake, Charles is ideal for small unit campouts or group activities. Facilities include program areas, campsites, and limited bathrooms.

Camp Sam Hatcher

A small primitive camping area, Hatcher is the place to go to get away from it all. Lots of area to camp with a large program field and shelter it's great for a unit campout or small district event. There's water but very limited bathroom facilities. Your unit will need to rent port-a-johns if you have a large group.
