

PREREQUISITE TRAINING

To qualify to attend Wood Badge, participants must have completed the basic training specific to their scouting position:

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills

(required for all Scoutmasters, assistant Scoutmasters, Varsity Coaches and assistant Varsity Coaches)

All participants are encouraged to complete the Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills training before attending a Wood Badge for the 21st Century course, but it is not required.

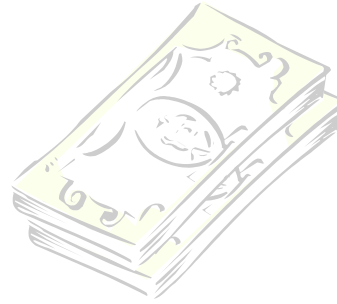

SR-1029 INFORMATION

Wood Badge Course SR-1029 is hosted by the East Carolina Council. This course will be conducted over two weekends. Participants should understand that during the first weekend they arrive at 7:00 am on Friday and depart on Sunday at 6:00 pm. The second weekend will begin at 7:00 am on Saturday and departure will be approximately 6:00 pm on Monday. Attendance during the entire course is required for completion.

WHAT IS WOOD BADGE FOR THE 21ST CENTURY?

The Wood Badge leadership training experience will consist of two weekends. During the first weekend, participants will be divided into groups that will operate as a patrol throughout the Wood Badge Course. Dining and sleeping accommodations will be provided (bring your own sleeping gear). The second weekend will involve an outdoor experience for participants where patrols provide for their own shelter and meals.

WHO MAY ATTEND

Wood Badge for the 21st Century is open to all scouting positions, i.e. Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, and Venture Scouts.

UNIFORMS

The uniform that you wear in your normal Scouting position will be the uniform that you will wear at Wood Badge. This uniform must include: official BSA shirt, trousers, web belt, socks and shoulder loops commensurate with your Scouting position.
