REGISTRATION FEES:

Troops will have two options when registering their Scouts and Adults for Winter Camp 2012

- 1. Meals Provided: \$90 per / \$35 per adult** (Includes all meals starting with Saturday—Monday breakfast)
- 2. Meals Not Provided: \$70 per Scout / \$20 per adult**

HOUSING: Participants should plan on bringing their own tents. Showers and restrooms will be available. Limited cabins space available for \$5 per bed.

REGISTRATION: All participants must register and pay by January 10, 2012. Late registration fee is \$10 per person. Registrations are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Make checks payable to East Carolina Council, BSA

INSTRUCTOR OPTION: Any adult leader who is interested in teaching a merit badge will attend at no cost with 1/2 off of the registration for one youth.

ADULT ACTIVITIES: We will have several adult supplemental trainings and activities for adults to participate : TBD, look for announcement in the ECC Newsletter

MERIT BADGE REGISTRATION: Merit Badge Registration will be through [BadgeTracker](#). After your registration is submitted you will receive an online username and password that will allow you to sign your Scouts up for the class of their choice.

There will be additional activities and merit badges for Scouts and Adults to participant in during the evening hours. These may include camp wide games, merit badges, campfire programs and general games and handicrafts.

WEBELOS CAMPING

This years Winter Camp will be open to Webelos Scouts. Several different Activity/Academic Pins and Activity Badges will be offered for Webelos to complete. All of the registration information applies for Webelos.

One Day Fee Option: For Webelos and their families interested in only staying one day (Saturday or Sunday) the registration fee is \$45 per Scout / \$15 per adult. Families arriving on Sunday can check in at 6:30 - 7:30 Saturday night.

CAMPING: There will be a Webelos only campsite for those who do not plan on staying with their affiliated Troop.
Troops: If a Webelos Den is not staying with you then you will not be sharing a campsite with another Troop is does have Webelos.
