Arrival Procedure

Vehicles must use Car Pass Procedures

3:00pm-8:00pm Arrival of Cub Families.

Gate Pass Procedure: Only ONE vehicle per pack is allowed back to camp at one time. Camper should drop gear and return vehicle to parking area so the next person can go back. Pack may also combine gear into a truck or trailer to get the gear back to the campsite quicker. Vehicles are allowed to bring trailers and cookers to the campsite but the tow vehicle counts and is not to be left at the campsite. ABSOLUTELY NO DRIVING ON THE GRASS AREAS ALL VEHICLES MUST STAY ON THE DRIVEWAYS NO EXCEPTIONS! These are Camp Boddie rules and must be adhered to.
