Letter from Scout Executive, Ray Franks

In this Fall Training Bulletin you will find a list of all the training we presently know that is being offered by the Districts and at the council level. Although many of the Districts have not scheduled a training session in October they remain ready to come to your Cub Scout Pack to carry out training. Phone numbers are listed for your convenience to contact your district training chair and line up training just for your unit leaders.

Beginning with December units must have a trained top leader (Cubmaster, Scoutmaster or Venture Crew Leader) to receive an unconditional charter.

If you receive a conditional charter you have no more than one year for your top leader to be trained. The following year a unit with a conditional charter will not be able to continue the unit.

Please do not wait until the last minute to address this problem if your top unit leader is not trained. All registered leaders, including Chartered Representatives must complete Youth Protection Training.

The Executive Board of East Carolina Council, BSA is committed to insuring the safety of every youth in our program by guaranteeing every unit is lead by a trained leader and every leader knows how to prevent youth from being harmed or abused. If you have any problems contacting your district training chairman, please contact the council training chairman, Pat O'Callaghan to assist you with your unit's training needs.
