- _____ **Cub Scouter of the Year** - Given to an Assistant Den Leader, Pack Committee Chair/ Pack Committee Member, or Assistant Cubmaster who has given above and beyond, to their unit facilitating quality programming and a fun environment
- _____ **Cubmaster of the Year** - Given to a Cubmaster who has given above and beyond, to the youth of their unit allowing them to grow, learn, and have fun
- _____ **Boy Scouter of the Year** - Given to the Assistant Scoutmaster or Committee Member who has done an outstanding job facilitating quality programming and a fun environment
- _____ **Scoutmaster of the Year** - Given to the Scoutmaster who has done an outstanding job leading their unit while encouraging youth leadership and utmost adherence to the Scout Oath and Law
- _____ **Venture Scouter of the Year** - Given to the Assistant Crew Advisor or Committee Member who has done an outstanding job supporting their unit throughout the year
- _____ **Venture Crew Advisor of the Year** - Given to a Venture Crew Advisor who has provided program and leadership opportunities to youth in a quality Venturing organization
- _____ **Unit Leader Award of Merit** – Awarded to Cubmasters, Scoutmasters, Venture Crew Advisors, and Skippers who excel in Leadership of their unit. Please use the official ULAM Application – all who qualify will be recognized – https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/pdf/512-003_WB.pdf
- _____ **Clement Eagle Scout Award** - Presented to an Eagle Scout from the 2022 Class in **the Pitt Historical District Area** who exhibited exceptional Scout Spirit through service to his unit, sponsoring organization, and community. Special consideration will be given for an outstanding Eagle Project that gave the highest level of leadership to others and exceptional service to a worthy institution
- _____ **Kay Williams Spirit Award** - Nominees from the **Blackbeard Historical District Area** who exhibit and share the Scouting Spirit that is infectious to others throughout the Blackbeard Area much like our dear scouter Kay Williams.
- _____ **KP Lindsay Award** - Nominees from **the Blackbeard Historical District Area** who serve this district with a level of service comparable to a past district scouter KP Lindsay.
- _____ **Hackney Award** - Presented to a recent Eagle Scout from the Blackbeard Historical District Area who continues to serve at a high level giving back to the program that gave so much to this Eagle.
- _____ **The District Award of Merit** - The District Award of Merit is a council award presented by Districts in the same manner as the Silver Beaver (a national award presented by councils.)
