## **History of Scouting in East Carolina Council**

A charter was granted to Wilson County in February 1918, the East Carolina Council was incorporated in the state of North Carolina Corporation Law. Mr. Penn T Watson was the first Lone Scout along with Mr. Sanders Darden in 1917. The first independent troop was in Wilson that was charted by the First Methodist Church in 1918. In 1924, service was extended to Eastern North Carolina and the County of Wilson of North Carolina, and the corporation's name was changed to East Carolina Council. In February of 1924, the council was registered in North Carolina as a non-profit corporation authorized to conduct its operations in that state. Mr. Ben E Eagles was the first President of Wilson Council. Mr. Eagles was the first one to receive the Silver Beaver Award the highest award in council. In 1928 Wilsonian Herbert H. Harris donated 141 acres of land near Bailey Scout Camp. It was named Camp Charles in his brother's honor. Troop 5 claimed to be the first one to use this camp.

Wilson Council was organized with over 20 counties in the 1930's. At the time the Scout Executive Mr. H. Travis stated to the Regional office in Atlanta on 1930 stating, "There is a fine Scouting spirit and attitude of coordination on the part of our of people and I predict a pleasant relationship between this area and its new "mother". I consider myself a present member of the great army of unemployed and shall be glad to consider any opening for which you feel, I could be recommended" After this Wilson County was called "East Carolina Council." In 1936 there was a fire and all records of our scouting history was loss. There are no records before April, 17, 1950 that we had changed our name.



### **History of Scouting in East Carolina Council Continued**

In 1967, Dr. Sam Hatcher made available 330 acres of land near Morehead City to East Carolina Council. In 1969, Congressman Herbert C. Bonner of Washington, NC gave 330 acres pm Broad Creek for a campsite. Another 470 acres was purchased from Weyerhaeuser, Denton and Evans family at Blount's Creek.

In 1975 East Carolina Council was moved to Kinston which provided a permanent office facility. A new headquarters was dedicated on October 31, 1976.

The Council's Croatan Lodge was chartered in 1940. Wilsonian who served as Croatan Chief are: Woody Harrison until 1960, Henry Skinner until 1963, and Joseph until 1977. Mr. Arnie Formo received the Lodge Founders Award in 1983. Mr. William (Red) McKemey and Mr. Arnie Formo built a Camp Masters Lodge.


